2. Virtual nodes focal0, ..., focal7 running Ubuntu 20.04 are now in service
3. The linux.cs.uchicago.edu name now points to the round-robin focal.cs.uchicago.edu, comprising the above nodes

Linux1,3,4,5 rebuilt with Ubuntu 20.04

1. Linux2 is available for use right now.
2. linux1,2,3 are now available.
3. linux4,5 are now available.
4. All servers are back in the linux.cs round robin.

vdesk service is rebuilt
