

Remote Desktop Linux

Techstaff has a new **Virtual Desktop** service called *vDesk* ¹⁾. vDesk is currently designed to assist with CS remote study, and especially visitors to CSIL. With vDesk, you can work with a remote Linux GUI through either your browser or a [downloadable application](#) (recommended).

Note: There are currently NO GPU systems available on the vDesk infrastructure. ²⁾
