

# Remote Desktop Linux

Techstaff has a new **Virtual Desktop** service called *vDesk* <sup>1)</sup>. vDesk is currently built to assist with CS remote study, and especially visitors to CSIL. With vDesk, you can work with a remote Linux GUI through either your browser or a [downloadable application](#) ([recommended](#)).

There are currently NO GPU systems available on the vDesk infrastructure. <sup>2)</sup>
